

Q &A for students **from another institution wanting to take courses at NCSU:**

Q: How do I start the process to cross-register for a course at your CRC college or university?

All registration must begin through your home school.

Q: Where do I find your academic calendar, course schedule and registration timeline and deadlines?

Q: Can I take care of cross-registration from my home campus or online or do I have to go to your campus to register?

Your home school CRC coordinator will take care of all registration.

Q: How will I find out if I am enrolled successfully in a course at your college or university?

You will be notified via e-mail when you are successfully enrolled.

Q: How do I drop a course at your college or university?

Anytime you need to make changes to your CRC registration, you must notify your home school's registrar's office.

Q: Do I pay anything extra for cross-registering for a course at your college or university?

Under the CRC agreements, regular tuition and fees are paid to your home institution. Certain special fees may be required for special courses at other colleges, and the student is responsible for paying such fees.

There is no CRC registration during summer sessions. Students who wish to take a summer course must register directly with the institution offering the course

Distance Education courses are not eligible under the Inter-Institutional Registration program. These courses are offered through Distance Education & Learning Technology Applications (DELTA) and are identified with a section number of 601 or higher
