

## **Section for students from another institution taking courses at Saint Augustine's**

**Q: How do I start the process to cross-register for a course at your CRC college or university?**

A: You would contact the Registrar's Office at your respective college or university to complete the CRC paperwork. The Registrar's Office will then forward the CRC paperwork to the Registrar's Office at Saint Augustine's College.

**Q: Where do I find your academic calendar, course schedule and registration timeline and deadlines?**

A: For the academic calendar, go to <http://www.st-aug.edu/Academics/Divisions.htm>. On the right hand side, select "2010-2011." Course schedules are posted on the Registrar's page. <http://www.st-aug.edu/administration/registrar.htm>.

**Q: Can I take care of cross-registration from my home campus or online or do I have to go to your campus to register?**

A: You cannot complete the CRC form via Internet; however, once you complete the paperwork at your home campus' Registrar's Office it will be forwarded to the Registrar's Office at Saint Augustine's College.

**Q: How will I find out if I am enrolled successfully in a course at your college or university?**

A: You will be notified by email by Saint Augustine's College.

**Q: How do I drop a course at your college or university?**

A: You will need to contact the Registrar's Office at your home institution. Your Registrar's Office will then notify our Registrar's Office in writing of your desire to drop a course.

**Q: Do I pay anything extra for cross-registering for a course at your college or university?**

A: No.

**Q: Can I take courses through CRC cross-registration during summer terms?**

A: No. CRC is not available during summer terms.

**Q: Can I take courses through CRC cross-registration that are online or a part of distance learning?**

A: Saint Augustine's College does not offer online or distance learning courses at this time.

**Q: What arrangements do I make to park on your campus as a CRC student?**

A: Students will need to obtain a visitor's pass from the Security booth when entering campus.

**Q: Is there any public transportation that will help me get to your campus?**

A: The CAT bus from the City of Raleigh is available for students.
