

## Saint Augustine's University CRC Cross-registration Q &A

### If you're a full-time Saint Augustine's student wanting to take a course at another CRC School...

**Q: Which colleges and universities are a part of the CRC cross-registration plan?**

A: Meredith College, NC State University, William Peace University, Saint Augustine's University, Shaw University and Wake Technical Community College. See details for each institution to the right.

**Q: How do I start the process to cross-register for a course at another CRC college or university?**

A: Obtain a CRC form from the Saint Augustine's Registrar's Office, fill in all information and obtain the necessary signatures.

**Q: Which people at my home college/university need to approve my registering for a course through CRC cross-registration?**

A: Your Faculty Advisor and Department Chair.

**Q: Can I take care of cross-registration from my home campus or online or do I need to go to the other campus to register?**

A: You cannot complete the CRC form via internet; however, once you complete the paperwork at your home institution, the Registrar's Office will forward to the visiting institution.

**Q: Is there a limit to the number of CRC cross-registration courses I can take per semester or a total for my college career?**

A: There is no limit to courses you can take for your college career. As a **full-time student** you are limited to two courses per semester.

**Q: How will I find out if I am enrolled successfully in a course at another CRC college or university?**

A: You will be notified via email by the visiting institution.

**Q: How do I drop a course at another CRC college or university?**

A: You will need to complete an add/drop form to the Registrar's Office at Saint Augustine's. The visiting institution will then be notified and will be asked to remove the student from the course.

**Q: How many hours do I have to take per semester at my home college or university to be considered full-time and therefore eligible for CRC cross-registration?**

A: Students' semester hours must total 12 or more between the home and visiting institutions.

**Q: Do I pay anything extra for cross-registering for a course at another CRC college or university?**

A: Students **will not be charged an additional fee**. Students who are placed in an overload status at the home institution due to registering for a CRC course will be billed appropriately.

**Q: Can I take courses through CRC cross-registration during summer terms?**

A: No. CRC is not available during summer terms.

**Q: Can registering for a course at a CRC college or university affect my financial aid?**

A: No.

**Q: Is there any public transportation that will help me get to the other CRC campuses?**

A: The CAT bus from the City of Raleigh is available for students.
